How did you feel on your first day?

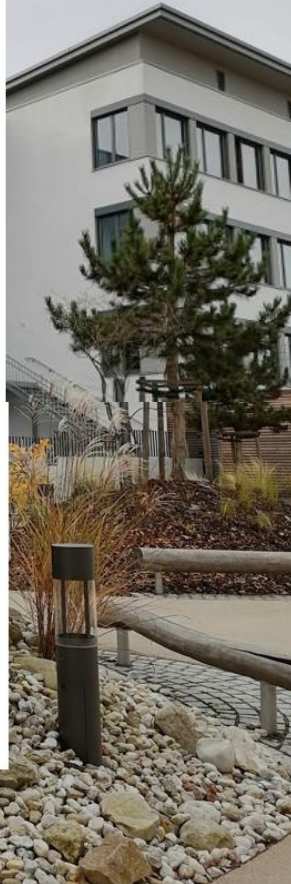
We were very excited and nervous because we didn't know how this school and teachers are. Before the school year started we got a tour through the school that was very exciting and we are definitely happy to be here.
