Rainbow-bread



Ingredients:

- 300ml of lukewarm milk
- 2 egg yolks
- 650g flour
- 5 tablespoons of sugar
- 1 pinch of salt
- 1.5 pack of dry yeast
- 75g butter
- different food coloring

- Grease the baking form
- Mix flour, dry yeast, sugar and salt. Whisk egg yolks in milk, add it with butter into the bowl and mix with a hand mixer.
- Knead the dough, separate it and colour it with the food colouring.
- Roll it out, lay it on top of the other pieces, make one big roll
- give it into the form, put a kitchen towel on top and wait 45 minutes
- Preheat the oven to 190°C and bake it for 30 minutes
- Let it cool off and enjoy eating it!

VOTING WITH 16?

It has been discussed very often if teenagers should vote at the age of 16 not 18. This has boosted up again with the global climate protests by teenagers. Right now, 16-year-olds are allowed to participate in all local elections and in some federal states but not Bavaria. The SPD, „Grüne“, „Linke“ and the FDP want to lower the age for voting at federal level to 16. However, the CDU and AfD are against that. To lower the age for the right to vote to 16, the constitution would have to be changed. That needs at least 2/3 of the representatives in the „Bundestag“ to agree to that change. Should we really do that?
